STUDY PROGRAMME FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Master Academic Studies - Architecture, in English (120 ECTS)

The Study programme Master Academic Studies - Architecture, in English, lasts two years.

NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR STUDENTS:

The number of students for the enrollment in the study programme is as follows:

- 10 self-financing students can enroll in the Master Academic Studies-Architecture, in English.

CONDITIONS:

To be eligible for the Master Academic Studies - Architecture applicants must have completed undergraduate academic studies in the field of Architecture or in another related field of education within the educational and scientific field of technical and technological sciences or the educational and artistic field of art, as defined by the Rulebook on scientific, artistic or professional areas within the educational and scientific, i.e., educational and artistic fields („Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia“ No.114/17), with at least 180 ECTS.

Prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of knowledge of English at a higher intermediate level of competence = B2 - Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or level of knowledge aligned to the CEFR (Common Framework of Reference for Languages).

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of Master Academic Studies - Architecture is determined on the basis of the overall grade achieved in undergraduate academic studies and the results achieved at the entrance exam.

For enrollment in the study programme, a candidate can score a total of 100 points, based on the overall grade achieved in undergraduate academic studies and based on the results achieved at the entrance exam:

- Overall grade achieved in bachelor academic studies is valued at up to 60 points
- The result at the entrance exam is evaluated up to 40 points.

The overall grade achieved in undergraduate studies is evaluated by taking into account the overall average grade, multiplied by the coefficient (6 - six).

The overall average grade achieved in previous studies is calculated as follows:

$$Pr = P \times B$$

Wherein: P – average grade in undergraduate academic studies, B – coefficient of study time which is a reduction factor for each additional year of study.

The value of the study time coefficients (B) is halved for each additional three years of study, i.e., the coefficients are 0.83 – for one additional study year, 0.67 – for two additional study years, 0.5 – for three additional study years and further in the following order 0.42, 0.33, 0.25, etc.

The number of points that a candidate can score based on the overall grade achieved in the previous level of study is a maximum of 60.

ENTRANCE EXAM:

Candidates who apply for enrollment in the Master Academic Studies – Architecture take the entrance exam, which is of a classification nature. The entrance exam consists of two parts:

- Quality of the portfolio – up to 20 points, and
- Test (and interview) – up to 20 points.

The candidate forms a portfolio and submits it in the term provided for the preparation of the test, together with the test. The content, number of pages and format of the portfolio, as well as the criteria for quality evaluation, are determined in more detail and published in the call for admission.

The content of the test, the duration of the test, as well as the method of evaluation, are determined in more detail and published in the call for admission. If necessary, after the written exam (test), the Commission may conduct an interview with the candidates.

Based on entrance exam the candidate can score a maximum of 40 points.

Tuition fee - studies in English: EUR 4,000.00.
