STUDY PROGRAMME IN ENGLISH FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Master academic studies:

Peace, Security and Development, in English, (60 ECTS)

Joint master's program of regional studies of Southeast Europe, in English, (120 ECTS)

** The Government of the Republic of Serbia has not made a Decision on the number of vacancies for student admission to the first year of study programmes financed from the budget for higher education institutions founded by the Republic for the academic year of 2023/2024. If budget places are not approved, they will be added to the number of self-financing students.*

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

In the first year of study programs of master academic studies in the study program Peace, Security and Development, in English, can be enrolled a candidate who has completed undergraduate academic studies with at least 240 ECTS, as well as a candidate who has completed four years of undergraduate studies, valid until the enactment of the Law on Higher Education. A candidate who has completed integrated studies or master academic studies, having achieved 300 ECTS credits, can also enroll in the first year of master academic studies. Applicants must enclose a certificate of English language proficiency (IELTS - score of at least 6, TOEFL - score of at least 95 and other equivalent certificates). Students who graduated from the Faculty of Political Sciences, Faculty of Philology, previous level of study in English as well as students whose mother language is English are exempted from submitting a certificate of English language proficiency.

Joint master's program of regional studies of Southeast Europe can be enrolled by candidate who has completed undergraduate academic studies with at least 180 ECTS (bachelor or equivalent), with basic knowledge of social and humanistic sciences – rights, policies, social , cultural and economic sciences - and general knowledge and interest of Southeast Europe.

Candidates are obliged to submit:

1. No less than one letter of recommendation (preferably/if possible from a university professor or the employer, in English language)

2. Certificate, i.e., diploma, of completed study programme of the first level of study (for Graz: translated into English or German language; for Belgrade: translated into English if it is not in one of the languages of the former Yugoslavia)
3. Certificate of passed exams from undergraduate studies (for Graz : translated into English or German language; for Belgrade: translated into English if it is not in one of the languages of the former Yugoslavia)
4. Motivation letter (in English language)
5. Curriculum vitae (in English language)
6. Proof of knowledge of the English language
7. For enrollment at the University of Belgrade, certified translation of a diploma, i.e., certificate of completed study programme from non Yugoslavian languages in Serbian will be requested afterwards.

All candidates will be interviewed, after which the final decision on enrollment is made.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of master academic studies is determined on the basis of the overall grade in undergraduate studies, the length of study at the previous level of studies and the results achieved at the entrance exam.

Entrance exam, including test of knowledge, aptitudes and abilities, is held in written and / or oral form (test, essay, interview with the commission).

For enrollment in the study programme, the applicant may score a maximum of 100 points in total, based on the overall grade in undergraduate studies and based on the results achieved at the entrance exam.

The overall average grade in undergraduate studies is valued at up to 50 points.

The length of study is evaluated up to 10 points, and at least 0.

The result of the entrance exam is evaluated up to 40 points.

The overall average grade in undergraduate studies is the average grade in undergraduate studies (which includes the grade of the thesis if any) and which is multiplied by 5.

For a person who has completed a master degree, the overall average grade of study (OAG) is calculated on the basis of average grade of study in Undergraduate Studies (GrUS) and Master Academic Studies (GrMS), weighted by the duration of the study programme in Undergraduate and Master Academic Studies expressed in ECTS credits (UScredit and MScredit):

$$\text{The overall average grade (OAG)} = (\text{GrUS} \times \text{UScredit} + \text{GrMS} \times \text{MScredit}) / (\text{UScredit} + \text{MScredit})$$

The length of study (LS) for enrollment in two-year master studies programme, if three-year undergraduate studies have been previously completed, is calculated by the following formula:

$$\text{LS} = 10 - (\text{ays} \times 3),$$

wherein ays = additional year of study in undergraduate studies.

The length of study (LS) for enrollment in one-year master studies programme, if four-year undergraduate studies have been previously completed, is calculated by the following formula:

$$LS = 10 - (ays \times 4),$$

wherein ays = additional year of study in undergraduate studies.

For a person who has completed undergraduate or integrated studies, the average grade and length of study at those studies are evaluated.

TUITION FEE:

The tuition fees for citizens of the Republic of Serbia - 124.000,00 dinars.

The tuition fees for foreign citizens - 1.500,00 euros for study program Peace, Security and Development, and for Joint master's program of regional studies of Southeast Europe (in dinar equivalent according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia, on the day of payment).
